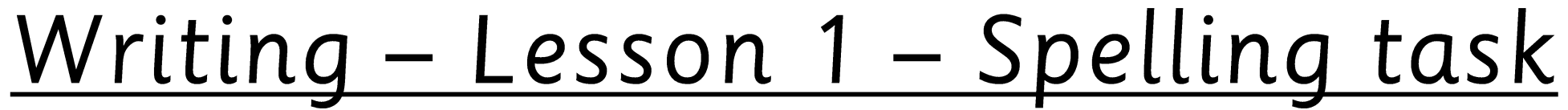

Writing - Lesson 2 - Imperative verbs.



A verb is a “doing” word. It describes an action, for example

- ran – Decon **ran** to the pasta bar.
- sneezed – Harry **sneezed** loudly.
- tiptoed – Layton **tiptoed** into the classroom.

Some verbs are more like instructions, things that you **must** do, these are called Imperative verbs.

I have used superlatives/ exaggeration. E.g. good=best.	
I have used eye catching memorable pictures.	
I have used a special offer to entice buyers.	
I have used a rhetorical question. E.g. Wouldn't you love to...?	
I have used bossy/ imperative verbs and strong adverbs.	
I have used positive adjectives and feelings, ignoring the negatives.	
I have given important product information.	
I have used bullet points, subheadings, labels and words that stand out.
