## Message from the teachers...

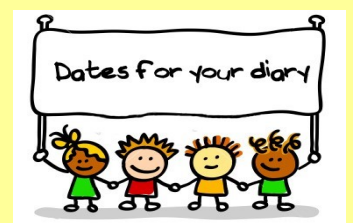

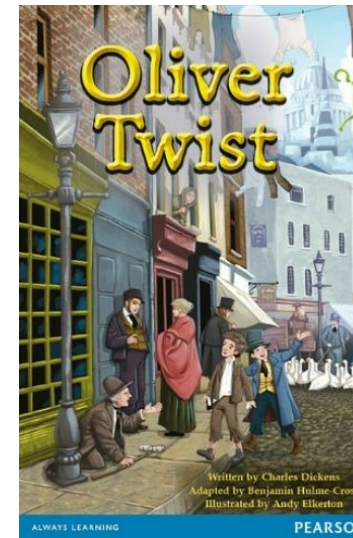
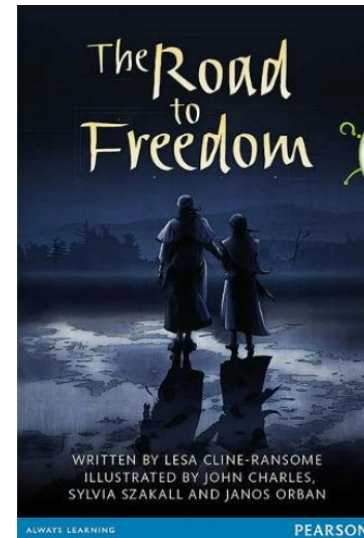


## In Science we will learn...

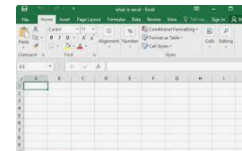


## In Music we will...

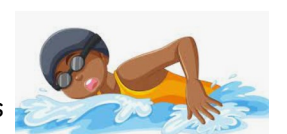
## In Art we will learn about ...
