In Science we will learn about...

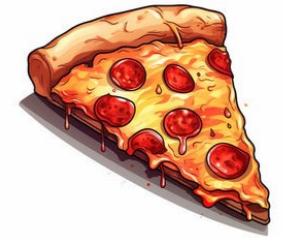


- Properties of Materials

In Food Technology we will...



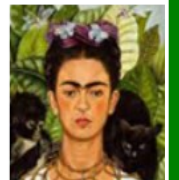
- know what food is grown, reared or caught.

- that the rainforest has a tropical climate.
- that the rainforest is being destroyed for grazing land.
- about Manaus and how it's an urban area of the rainforest and has favelas which is small shanty towns.
