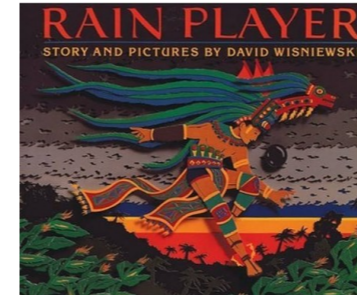
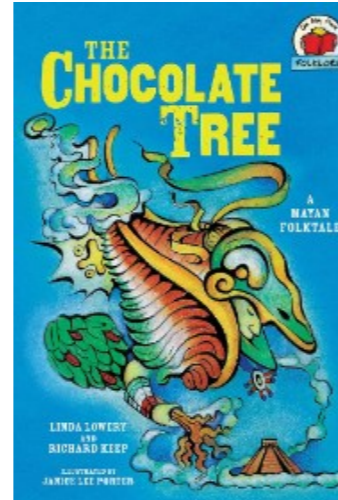


In Science we will learn about...

In Food Technology we will...

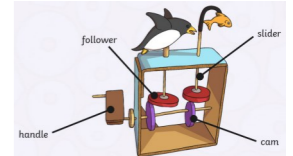


Be making a pizza.

- evaluate my design.
- compare my design against other people's products.

In PE we will ...

- have two lesson of PE each week- handball and tag rugby
- In handball we will play games and learn new skills, strategies and tactics to outwit the opposition. We will learn about fair play, honesty and game rules.
